



GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Based on PVC resin with a variety of functional processing additives, using Ca/Zn stabilisers.

HAZARDOUS IDENTIFICATION

Heritage Embossed Cladding is non-harmful in the solid state. For high speed cutting or machining local exhaust ventilation, LEV is recommended to remove fumes and dust.

HANDLING AND STORAGE

As the Heritage Embossed Cladding is a solid board the hazard designation is void. However, avoid the inhalation of dusts, if the product is abraded, machined or polished. Local exhaust ventilation, LEV, is recommended to remove fumes and dust. The first aid measures need to be taken when the product is a dust format only.

Store between 5 and 25°C in a dry, well-ventilated place away from sources of heat, ignition and direct sunlight. The boards should be full supported or have supports at a maximum of 1mtr centres.

EXPOSURE CONTROL / PERSONAL PROTECTION

If dust is generated when using the Heritage Embossed Cladding boards, avoid inhalation. Where reasonably practicable, this should be achieved by the use of local exhaust ventilation and good general extraction. If these are not sufficient to maintain concentrations or dusts below the relevant occupational; exposure limit, suitable respiratory protective equipment should be worn.
